



# Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)

Our CLIL programs are designed for educators who have a language background other than English and who teach, or want to teach, course content using English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI).

## Why CLIL at ICTE?

For more than a decade, The University of Queensland's Institute of Continuing & TESOL Education (ICTE) has delivered CLIL training to education professionals across the globe.

The program supports participants to:

- Enhance their ability to teach academic course content in English
- Develop teaching materials that engage learners and support their learning of content and language.
- Use practical skills and techniques to effectively manage the learning process

The program supports universities to:

- Attract international students to campus through the increased delivery of courses taught in English
- Enhance the English language level of local students and prepare them for their own study abroad experience
- Develop their internationalisation strategy and vision.

## Program Content

Participants take part in practical workshops and apply practical teaching ideas and strategies to their own teaching materials.

Sample topics include:

- Motivating learners
- Adapting texts
- Selecting and designing interactive tasks
- Sequencing content in lectures and lessons
- Supporting students' language development and output
- Developing students' cognitive and critical thinking skills.

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# CLIL Program Options

## Open Enrolment Program

The CLIL Higher Education (CLIL-HEd) program is held at ICTE in Brisbane, Australia and is open to tertiary-level educators, individuals and small group enrolments.

### CLIL Higher Education (CLIL-HEd) Program

<b>Length:</b>	2 weeks / 40 hours
<b>Participants:</b>	This is an introductory level program for academics who have not participated in a previous CLIL program with ICTE.
<b>Content:</b>	Each day includes a mixture of theory, applied methodology and practical ideas for teaching.

## CLIL Higher Education

The CLIL-HEd program is designed for University Academics who have a language background other than English and who teach, or want to teach, course content using English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI).

## Customised Programs

ICTE can design and deliver customised CLIL programs to meet the needs of your institution, including primary, secondary and tertiary educators. The following programs can be delivered at The University of Queensland, or in offshore locations at your school, university or organisation.

### CLIL Foundations

<b>Length:</b>	Typically 1 or 2 weeks / 15-20 hours per week
<b>Core content:</b>	Exploring CLIL methods and techniques which support delivery of content, language and learning skills.

### CLIL plus English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI)

<b>Length:</b>	Typically 1 week / 15-20 hours
<b>Core content:</b>	Applying CLIL approaches and enhancing educators' English language skills for teaching content in English.

### Approaches to Teaching in Higher Education (Active Learning)

<b>Length:</b>	Typically 1 week / 15-20 hours
<b>Core content:</b>	Engaging students through active learning and incorporating approaches into Higher Education.

CLIL Extensions Workshops are also available.

## Entry Requirements

It is recommended participants have a minimum level of English language proficiency of CEFR\* B2 or equivalent

*\*ICTE programs align with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)*
